This Course presents concepts for designing and building Web sites. It covers how to plan the structure of a Web site, maintaining the Web site files, and considering the affect that various browsers, monitors, and systems can have on the display of a site. Strategies for making a site download quickly and display well across all browsers and systems are presented, along with creating colour schemes, backgrounds, GIF transparencies, and image maps.

Additional topics covered in this series include the use of HTML and graphics for formatting and layout, and other useful tools such as frames, animated GIFs, dynamic HTML, JavaScript, QuickTime, Flash, and Shockwave will be topics that will be looked into.

The Study session will be supported by qualified teachers with set lessons. Once the lessons are complete students can get their skills certified by taking professional exams in addition to the Eden House Certificate you obtain.

**Part Two:** offers a unique focus on project management and a professional approach towards the completion of projects which includes approaching clients, preparing proposals, conducting interviews/meetings, asset collection, technical skills, and related legal issues.

Students completing the whole program will be able to approach commercial web designing (and development) in a professional manner.
